Te Rūnanga o Arowhenua (Arowhenua) and Aoraki Environmental Consultancy Limited (AECL) thank you for the opportunity to provide feedback on the subdivision consent of 21 Melrose Road prepared by David Harford Consulting Limited (ref: 259 and dated 30 November 2023) on behalf of Allenton Rugby Football Club (Incorporated) to enable the creation of one additional allotment from Lot 2 DP 382372.
