#### **Executive Summary**

Tēnā koutou Katoa,

I hope you had a lovely Christmas, and I wish you a happy new year.

A special thanks goes out once again to the dedicated team who worked tirelessly over the holiday period to keep our roads safe and dry. Despite challenging weather conditions and a reduced workforce, their commitment ensured the continued safety of our community.

The new year started off with a first day back safety focus workshop in which we reminded ourselves and our teams of the risks we face while working on the network. We also did a first day back for all plant items used on site, ensured that they have been inspected and deemed safe to use.

Our delivery teams established on site and started work with their respective programmes.

Our cyclic teams focussed on a few urgent CRMs before getting back to their routine maintenance program. They also installed 81 variable school times signs to the existing 30 Kura School signs around the district before the variable speed limit came into effect.

It was a wet start to 2025 with 111mm of rain falling in the past 30 days. The rain combined with warm weather boosted weed growth around the district and has kept our trading partner busy getting this under control.

We have conducted Night-Time Surveys across all roads in Ashburton, assessing signage improvements or hazards around the district.

- Annual sump cleaning completed

Our Cyclic teams will continue with pothole repairs and sign maintenance across the network. The teams will also keep an eye on CRM's and address any urgent tasks.


