Executive Summary

Tēnā koutou Katoa,

Our heavy maintenance teams continued with digout repairs in the northeastern quadrant of the network. Meanwhile, our surfacing team began work on Pole Road, where they surfaced and sealed all remaining digouts before heading to the northeast to complete the open digouts.

Our cyclic teams continued to fill potholes and maintain road sign across the network, while focussing on urgent as it comes up.

Maintenance Grading carried on throughout the month, with a few additional sites graded due to condition after rainfall.

Our trading partners ensured that street cleaning and vegetation control/weed is on schedule and that any CRM's is dealt with effectively.

We have made significant progress on our unsealed roads rating data survey, with 85% completed to date. All Faults data capturing is also progressing well ensuring council has access to the most accurate and up-to-date information.
