Executive Summary

Tēnā koutou Katoa,

A huge effort was put in by our cyclic teams during the month of August 2024 to get on top off all open potholes and get ahead with pre-reseal repairs. By the end of the month, an impressive total of 1,379 potholes were filled. Additionally, the team effectively managed surface flooding during rain events and responded swiftly to downed trees during windstorms. Their work also included sign maintenance, sweeping, and handling urgent CRM requests.

The Unsealed Road Rehabilitation Program was successfully concluded by our Heavy Maintenance Team, followed by a shift in focus towards spot metalling, drainage enhancements, and minor recovery tasks for the remainder of the month. The next phase will involve commencing repairs on sealed roads

Our Minor Maintenance teams completed footpath repair work and urgent drainage jobs across the network.

Our Trading Partners continued their commitment to maintaining the network, which involved sweeping and cleaning the streets, managing vegetation growth, performing line marking, and diligently grading and maintaining unsealed roads.

Upcoming Planned Works – September 2024

Overview

Our Heavy Maintenance Team is on track to complete the unsealed road rehabilitation projects scheduled for this half of the financial year. They will then tidy up a few CRM's before beginning work on the Digouts programmed for the remainder of the year.

Our Minor Maintenance teams will assist with pre-seal repairs, concentrating on isolated digouts, while still looking after urgent CRM's and drainage work.

Potholes and signs will be on the Cyclic Teams radar, as well as a few urgent bridge maintenance jobs and making a start on pre-seal repairs.

Our supervisory team will be inspecting reseal sites to programme pre-reseal repairs, continue with all-faults and night-time inspections.
